Module/Unit 1: Old English Poetry Learning Objectives:

Upon completion of this module, the student will be able to demonstrate proficiency in the following ways:

Module/Unit 2: Medieval English Literature

Upon completion of this module, the student will be able to demonstrate proficiency in the following ways:

1. The student will write sentences to demonstrate proficiency in the use of commas. (L1, L2)
2. The student will read and interpret Medieval English. (RL4, RL7)
3. The student can recognize theme, author's style, and satire in a literary work (RL1, L6,).
4. The student will read and write a narrative piece and use figures of speech (L1, L2, L6, W3, W6, W8).
5. The student will identify the plot in a narrative piece (RL4, L2)
6. The student will create a Modern-Day Tale. (L1, L2, L5, SL2, SL5, W8, W6, W3, RL4, RI7)

Module/Unit 3: The Drama of the Renaissance

Upon completion of this module, the student will be able to demonstrate proficiency in the following ways:

Module/Unit 4: Analyzing Literature
